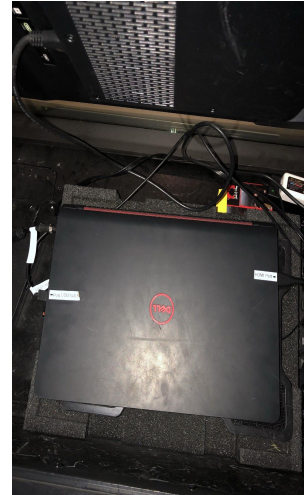


Mirror Booth

- Take the mirror booth road case and put it wherever you are setting up the photo booth.
- Lay the booth down, and undo all the latches so you can take the cover off.
- Now slowly lift the mirror booth back up so it is upright.
- Take the flash out of the case it is in, and put it together. Once it is together, screw the flash to the top of the booth.
- Take the wires that are hanging inside the booth to plug into the flash and make sure the switch is turned on.
- Next take the sound bar out of its case and place on top of the booth itself, directly under the flash. It just sits there, it doesn't clip in or anything.
- Power up the sound bar.
- Next take the Laptop out of the case and place inside the door that is located at the back of the photo booth.
- Plug the charger that is located in



- Plug the USB hub into the USB port that says “Plug USB Hub Here.”
- Open up the laptop and turn it on now.
- Now take your printer out and place it on whatever table it is going. Run an IEC cord for power.
- Next run the USB printer cable through the whole on the bottom right of the back of the booth, and plug it into the USB Hub that is on the right.
- Now everything should be wired up properly so you can start the “Mirror Me Booth” program.
- Once that program is open find the event you are working and click that event, then click “Start Preset”.
- Close the laptop or else the laptop will be displayed sideways on the TV.
- Take the frame out of the bag and put onto the booth.
- Now go to the front of the booth and turn the TV on with the TV remote.
